Departures Lounge, Terminal TB3, Cairo International Airport Construction work on this 190,000m² terminal is scheduled for completion in 2007. Designed to cater for Cairo's rapidly expanding airport traffic, the new terminal will handle 7 million international and 3 million domestic passengers annually.

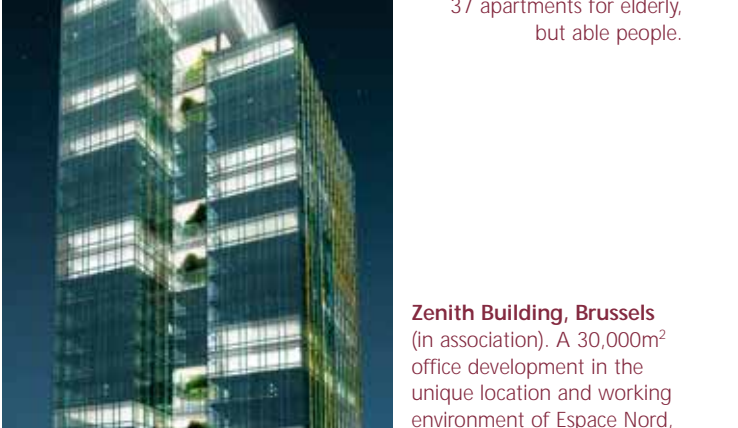

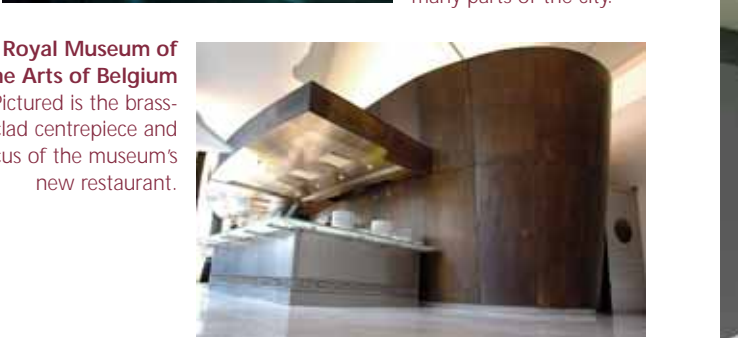

3rd Generation Accommodation, Brussels A hospitality establishment with 217 beds including 37 apartments for elderly, but able people.

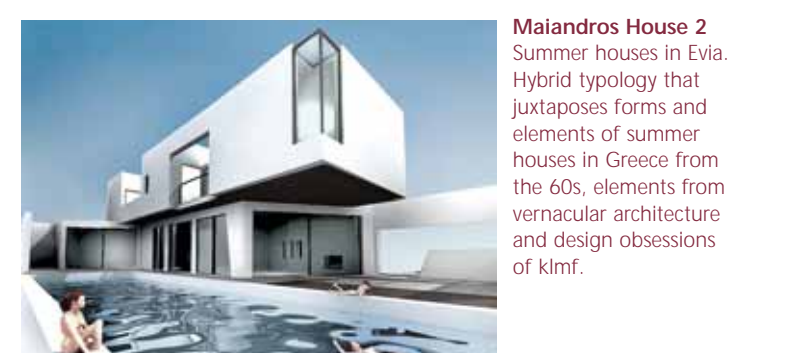

Modern Art Gallery 'Elektrownia', Radom Adaptation and redevelopment of an old power station. Total area of 5,370 m². Competition winning project.

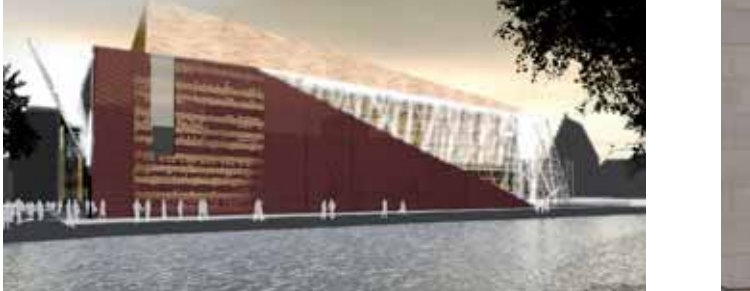

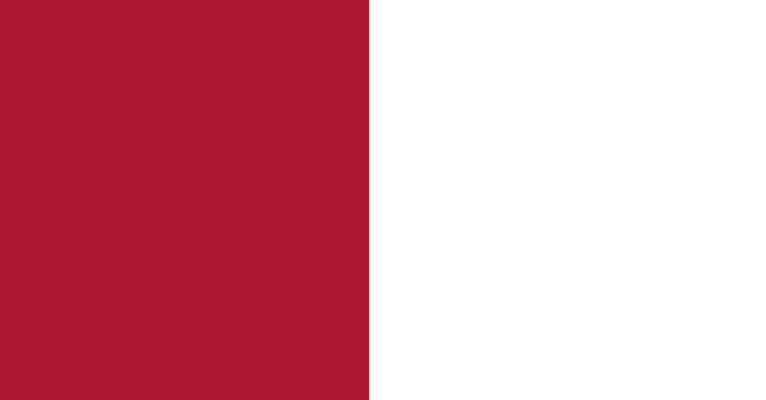

Murray Ó Laoire Architects



Carton Hotel, Carton Demesne Co Kildare This project, completed May 2006, involved the conservation and conversion of Carton House into a '4-star plus' hotel. The scheme comprises 165 bedrooms, 147 of which are in a new-build hotel block, and 18 of which are in the original main house; bars and restaurants; a banqueting hall and a leisure centre and spa.



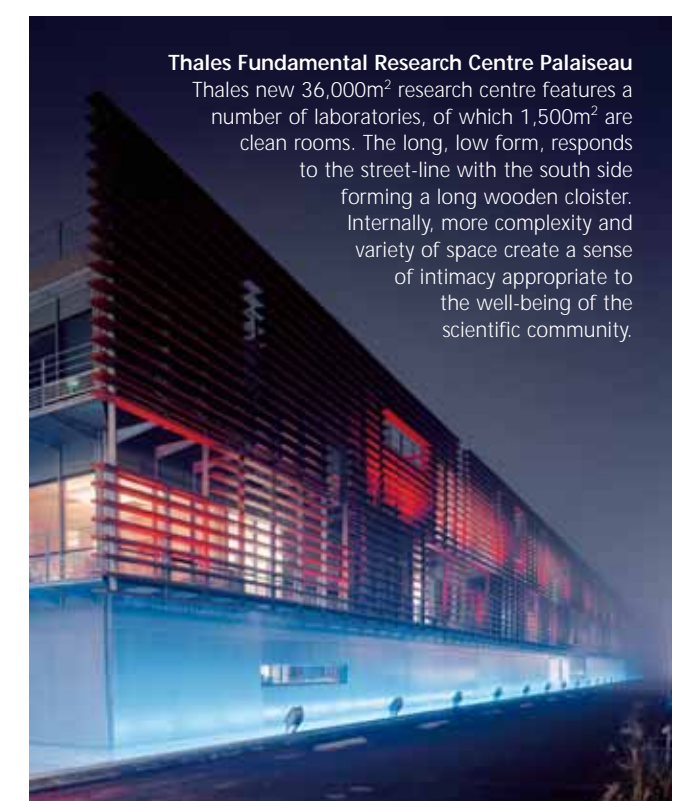
International Congress Centre, Rostov-On-Don The scheme accommodates a 23-storey four star hotel, an 800 seat congress hall, business centre, elite retail centre and incorporated underground and surface parking.

UL Thomond Student Village, Limerick Student accommodation sited on promontories created to preserve the natural flood plain and the seasonal nature of the landscape.

Office development for SNC Newton, Clamart This new office development in the south-west of Paris is located in a fast-growing business and high-tech R&D area. The 45,000m² building can be divided into various units, each with a separate entrance if required. Air conditioning is provided throughout and there is parking for 1100 cars at basement level. The largely-glazed façades are designed in response to the magnificent landscape in which the building is set close to Avenue du Général de Gaulle.



Thales Fundamental Research Centre Palaiseau Thales new 36,000m² research centre features a number of laboratories, of which 1,500m² are clean rooms. The long, low form, responds to the street-line with the south side forming a long wooden cloister. Internally, more complexity and variety of space create a sense of intimacy appropriate to the well-being of the scientific community.

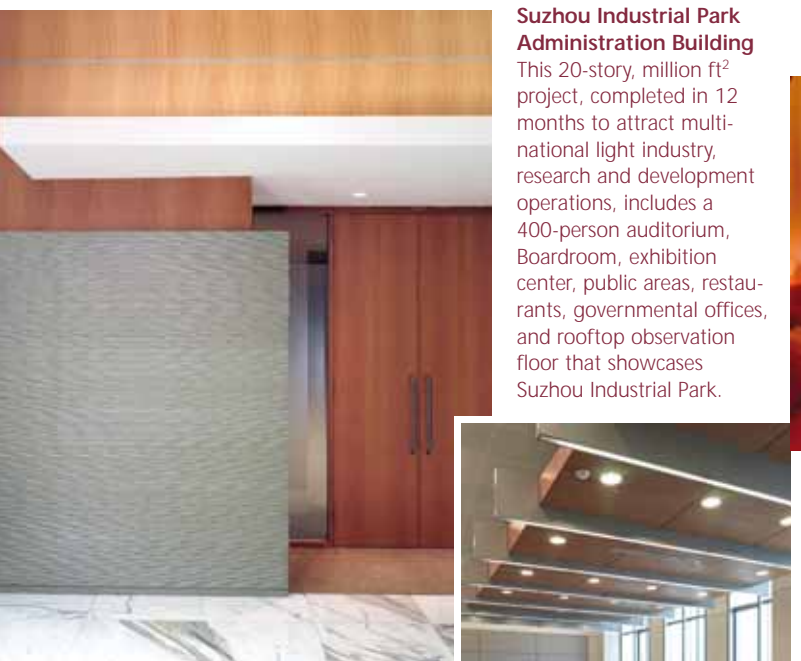
Tegholms Have, South Harbour, Copenhagen 142 full-ownership apartments for MT Højgaard. 12,600m² gross completed in 2006.

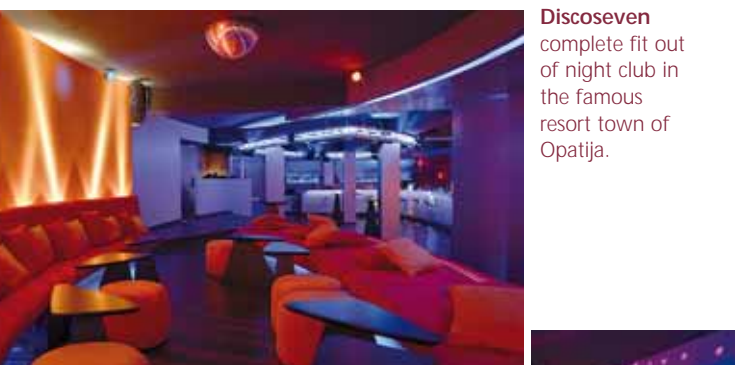

The hotel comprises 105 guestrooms, a main restaurant, bar, outdoor bar and terrace together with a swimming pool. 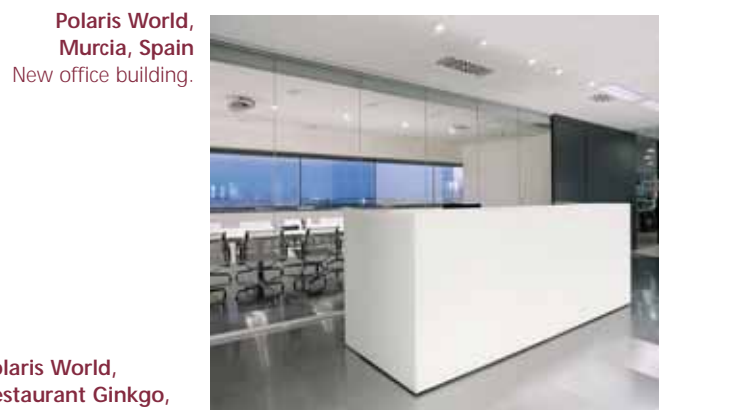
